

Parent bill of Rights

We safeguard the fundamental right for Parents to make decisions concerning Their Children

(As Mandated by HB8)

In order to promote parental involvement in our school systems, Focus Learning Academies adopt the Parent Bill of Rights. As required by Ohio HB 8, the school shall inform the parents:

- **“Sexuality Content”**
 - Before teaching any lessons that include sexual content and will allow parents to opt their children out of these lessons.
 - The School prohibits sexual content instruction to students in grades K-3.
- **Health and Wellbeing**
 - Any changes in the child’s health or well-being, including attending counseling services or requesting to be called by a different name or pronoun, including at the following:
 - Academic performance
 - Any significant sickness or physical injury, or any psychological trauma, any harassment, intimidation or bullying,
 - Any requests by a student to be identified as a gender that does not align with the student’s biological sex,
 - Any exhibition of suicidal ideation or persistent symptoms of depression or severe anxiety.

Focus Academies allow and encourage parents to participate in their children’s education and development.

- **Appeal Process**

Parents shall be permitted to file concerns with school administration and have access to multi-tiered appeal process.
