Our values shine through every action we take as a school. We believe that, in order to instill strong values in our students, we must live by example.

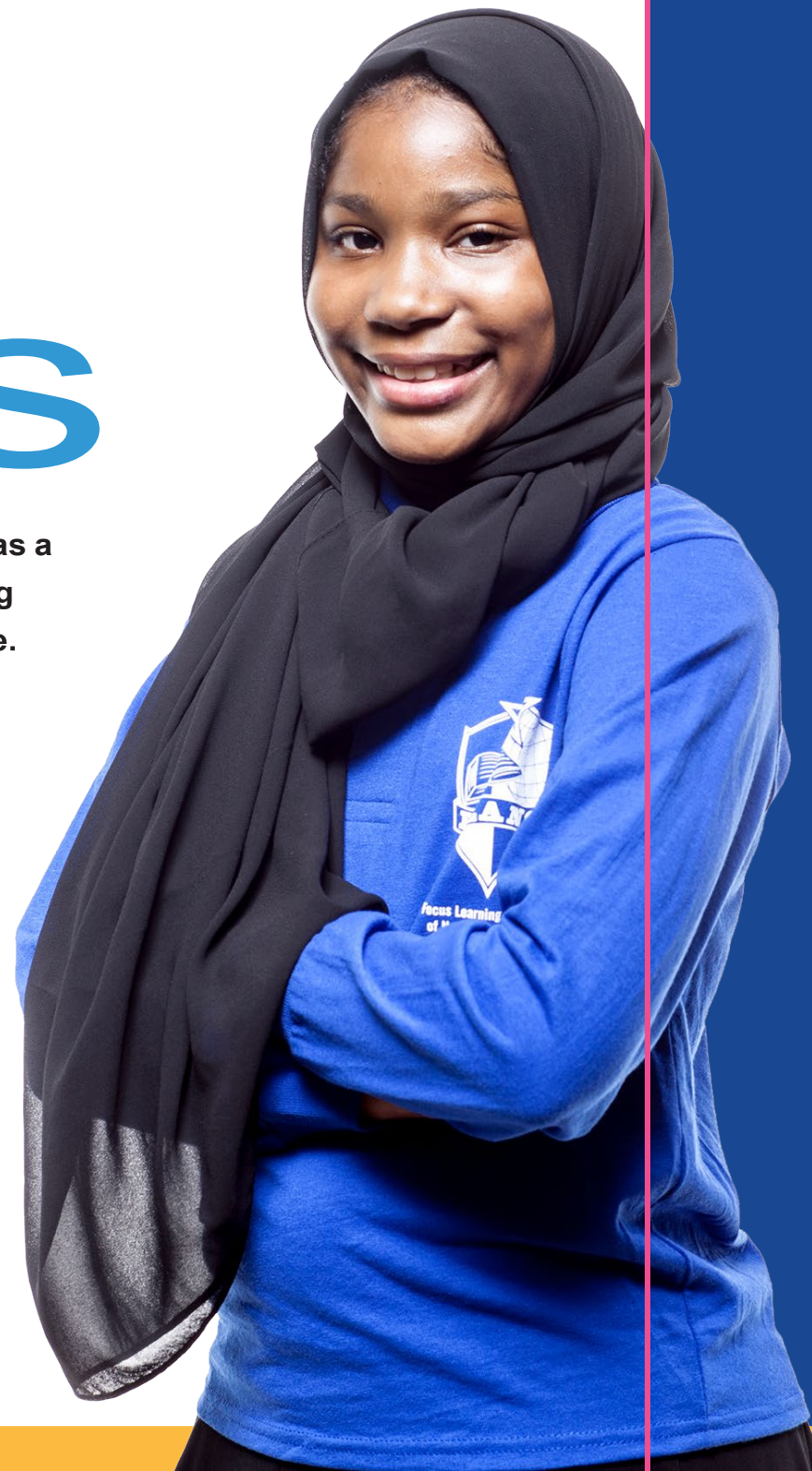
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Stand up & own it

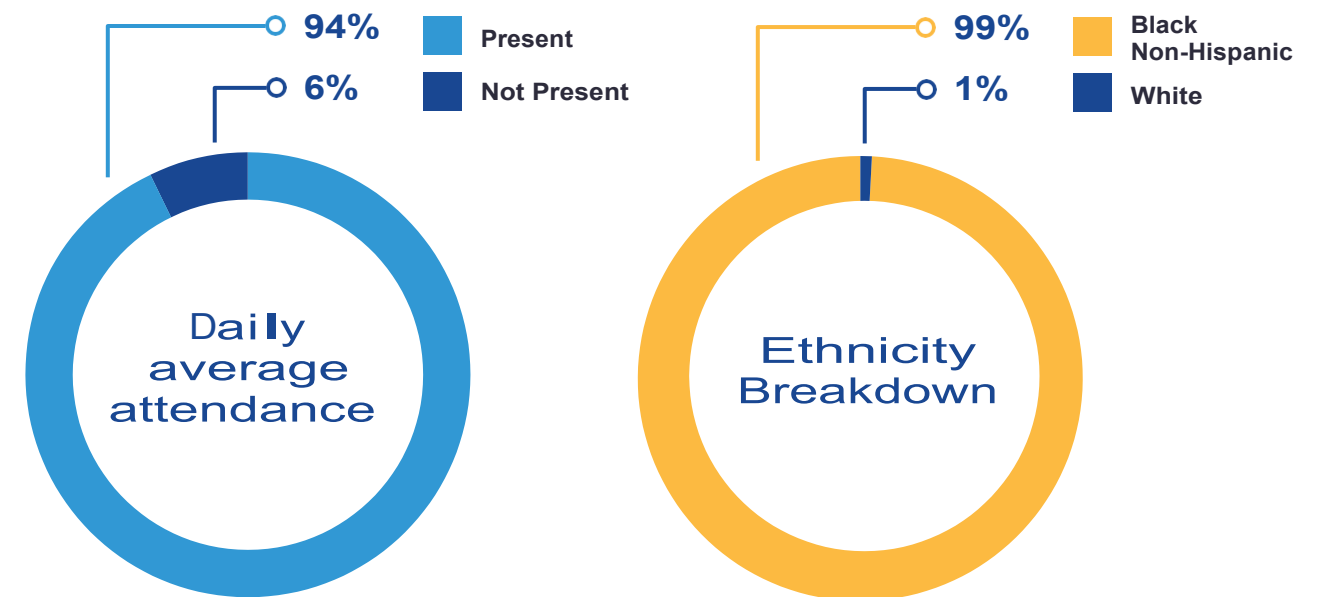


Central Breakdown by grade
